Dr. Lanktree is an Associate Professor and Clinician Scientist at St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton, Population Health Research Institute, and McMaster University. He received a Carl W. Gottschalk Research Scholar Grant in 2023 and the Jared J. Grantham Research Fellowship award in 2017. In the interview, Dr. Lanktree discusses his work in multiomics and genomics and hopes to apply his lab's "new findings to improve care of people with kidney diseases."
